Criteria for Grading Academic Submissions:

- Your term paper should be comprehensible to those unfamiliar with the topic.
- It should be written in a good style, well formatted (MLA Style, the latest edition), and proofread, demonstrating a thorough knowledge of the subject.
- A clear outline and plausible thesis statement, which states the topic and main insight in the introduction and is confirmed in the conclusion.
- Be aware of consistency, good transitions and paragraph organization to maintain the logical flow.
- My guiding questions and criteria for grading are:
 - Does the chosen secondary literature support the thesis?
 - Is it sophisticated or in any way theoretical?
 - Is the criticism adequately summarized and also critically reflected upon?
 - \circ Is there a good balance between observations/opinions and textual evidence?
 - What is the quality of the thesis statement; is it confirmed in the conclusion?
